**Marshall Area Fire Fighters Ambulance Authority
Capital Equipment Millage Renewal Proposal**

This proposal will allow the Marshall Area Fire Fighters Ambulance Authority to continue the same number of mills required to be levied on all property at .20 mills to replace capital equipment that is necessary to deliver emergency medical services to the community. Examples of necessary capital equipment that would be purchased as replacement equipment are ambulances, cardiac monitors, and ambulance cots. This is not an increase in tax over the same tax that has been levied for the past ten years, but a continuation of the same capital equipment millage.

Shall the existing tax rate limitation previously approved by the electors of the Marshall Area Fire Fighters Ambulance Authority, Calhoun County, Michigan, .20 mills (\$0.20 on each \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) for a period of 10 years, 2017 through 2026, inclusive, be renewed at .20 mills (\$0.20 on each \$1,000.00 of the taxable valuation) for a period of 10 years 2027 through 2036, inclusive, as a renewal millage for the purpose of funding replacement ambulances, cardiac monitors, ambulance cots, and other capital equipment. These funds will not be used for operations or payroll. The estimated amount of revenue that will be collected by the Authority in the first year that the millage is authorized and levied is \$270,862.00.

**Clarendon Township
Fire Protection Millage Renewal**

Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Clarendon Township, of 1.25 mills (\$1.25 per \$1,000 of taxable value), permanently reduced by Headlee (MCL 211.34d) to 1.2450 mills be renewed at 1.2450 mills (\$1.25 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for 5 years, 2026 through 2030 inclusive, for fire protection, raising an estimated \$46,622.89 in the first year the millage is levied of which a portion will be disbursed to such other or fewer local units of government as the Township Board determines appropriate?

**Fredonia Township
Millage To Fund Fire Protection Services**

Shall the Township of Fredonia impose an increase of up to one-half (.5) mills (\$0.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the Township tax levy limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for two (2) years inclusive, 2026 – 2027, for fire protection services, including, but not limited to, maintenance and operation of the Fredonia Township Fire Department and the purchase and housing of fire apparatus and equipment, which one-half (.5) mills increase will raise an estimated \$50,866.00 in the first year the millage is levied?

**Marengo Township
Operating Millage Renewal Proposal**

Shall the tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes within Marengo Township imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution now reduced from the allocated one (1) mill to .8387 for said township be renewed at and increased for said township by .1613 mills (\$0.1613 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for the period of 2027 through 2032, inclusive, for general township operating purposes; and shall the township levy such increase in millage for said purpose, thereby raising the first year an estimated \$22,146.97 (this is a renewal of operating millage)?

**Marshall Township
Fire Protection Services Millage Renewal**

Shall the previously voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Marshall Township that is set to expire on December 31, 2026, of 1.5 mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to 1.4514 mills (\$1.4514 of per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage roll backs, be renewed at and increased up to the original voted 1.5 mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for 2027 through 2036, inclusive, for the purpose of acquiring new fire trucks, firefighting equipment, capital improvements and operation expenses of the Marshall Township Fire Department, thereby raising in the first year the millage is levied an estimated \$394,841.

**Pennfield Township
Public Safety Millage**

Shall the Charter Township of Pennfield impose an increase of up to 6 mills (\$6.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitations imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for eight (8) years, 2026 through 2033 inclusive to pay for the cost of providing police and fire protection services to the residents of the Township. The 6 mill increase will raise an estimated \$1,885,148.028 in the first year the millage is levied?

**Albion District Library
Library Millage Renewal Proposal**

Shall the Albion District Library, County of Calhoun, be authorized to levy a millage annually in an amount not to exceed 2.4777 mills (\$2.4777 per \$1,000 of taxable value), which is a renewal of the millage rate that expires in 2026, against all taxable property within the Albion District Library district for a period of ten (10) years, 2027 through 2036, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all district library purposes authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue the Albion District Library will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Albion District Library in the first year (2027) is approximately \$750,000. To the extent required by law, a portion of the revenues from this millage will be captured within the district and disbursed to the Brownfield Redevelopment Authority of the City of Albion. Pursuant to an agreement, 25% of the millage revenues received from the portion of the District Library district located in Albion Township will be disbursed to the Homer Public Library.
