**STATE PROPOSAL 22-1**

A proposal to amend the state constitution to require annual public financial disclosure reports by legislators and other state officers and change state legislator term limit to 12 total years in legislature

**STATE PROPOSAL 22-2**

A proposal to amend the state constitution to add provisions regarding elections

**STATE PROPOSAL 22-3**

A proposal to amend the state constitution to establish new individual right to reproductive freedom, including right to make all decisions about pregnancy and abortion; allow state to regulate abortion in some cases; and forbid prosecution of individuals exercising established right

**BURLINGTON TOWNSHIP LIBRARY MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

Shall the Burlington Township Library be authorized to levy a renewal of additional tax annually upon the taxable value of all property subject to ad valorem taxation within the Township of Burlington in an amount not to exceed .3 mills (\$.30 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a six (6) year duration commencing 2023, through 2028, inclusive to provide funds for all Library purposes authorized by law? This millage is estimated to provide revenues of \$13,489.50 in the first year levy.

**HASTINGS AREA SCHOOL SYSTEM OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

**EXEMPTING PRINCIPAL RESIDENCE AND OTHER PROPERTY EXEMPTED BYLAW .5 MILL FOR 6 YEARS FOR HEADLEE RESTORATION PURPOSES, IF NECESSARY**

**LAWRENCE MEMORIAL DISTRICT LIBRARY MILLAGE PROPSAL**

Shall the Lawrence Memorial District Library, Counties of Kalamazoo and Calhoun, Michigan, be authorized to levy annually a new additional millage in an amount not to exceed .74 mill (\$.74 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) against all taxable property within the Lawrence Memorial District Library district for a period of ten (10) years, 2022 to 2031, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all district library purposes authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue the Lawrence Memorial District Library will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Lawrence Memorial District Library in the first year (2022) is approximately \$79,000.
